Ethylene Glycol

Description:

Ethylene glycol is an odorless, colorless liquid that is completely miscible with water and many organic liquids. It is used as an antifreeze and deicing agent. Large quantities of ingested ethylene glycol are toxic and will result in death.

Application:

Ethylene glycol is primarily used in oil & gas industry to lower freezing point of work-over fluids, especially in high producing gas wells.
